Re: Harris Base Achieves Pennsylvania License

Air Methods Corporation d.b.a.: Life Net of New York is pleased to announce that the Life Net 7-5 helicopter based in Harris, New York has received licensure by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for air medical operations. The Life Net 7-5 aircraft is located at Catskill Regional Medical Center and is staffed by an EMS pilot, flight nurse and flight paramedic team. This team is stationed at the base and ready for immediate response 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Operations are further supported by on-site aviation maintenance personnel.

The Harris location is approximately a 7 minute flight time from the Pennsylvania state border. This location allows for rapid response to scene and interfacility transport requests in Wayne, Pike, and surrounding counties. Life Net of New York aircraft complete interfacility transfers based on established referral patterns and scene flight transports to the closest most appropriate facility that meets the patient's medical needs.
